

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

I, Dorothy Harris Dorough, a resident of the City of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking any and all wills and testamentary dispositions heretofore made by me:

ITEM I. I direct that all of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness and funeral, be paid by my Executor, hereinafter named, as soon after my death as he shall deem advisable.

ITEM II. I do hereby give, devise and bequeath to my beloved husband, James Lee Dorough, the following described real estate:

Commence at the NW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 17, R 1 E. From said corner go N 87° 30' E 165 feet for point of beginning; thence S 2° 30' E 1320 feet; thence N 87° 30' E 330 feet; thence N 2° 30' W 1320 feet; thence S 87° 30' W 330 feet to point of beginning,

to have and hold in fee simple, and to be his absolutely.

In the event my beloved husband, James Lee Dorough, should predecease me, or in the event we should die in a common accident or calamity, I do hereby give, devise and bequeath said property described above to my beloved step-son, Ronald Lee Dorough, of Leeds, Alabama.

ITEM III. I do give, devise and bequeath to my beloved first cousin, Charles J. Christian, Jr., of Pascagoula, Mississippi, my diamond ring, which ring contains a diamond stone of approximately 67/100 of a carat, mounted in a green gold mounting, with an old gold shank. This is the diamond ring which I owned at the time of my marriage to James Lee Dorough.

ITEM IV. All the rest and residue of my estate, real, personal or mixed, and wheresoever situate, I do give, devise and bequeath to my beloved husband, James Lee Dorough, to be his absolutely and in fee simple.

ITEM V. I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my beloved husband, James Lee Dorough, as the Executor of this my last will and testament, and I hereby specifically exempt him from giving any bond or bonds whatsoever in connection with his appointment as Executor of my estate and in connection with the administration of my estate by him. I do hereby further specifically exempt my said Executor from filing any inventory and from making any report whatsoever to any court or person of his acts and doings as the Executor of my estate.
