

Before me, Martha B. Joiner, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared L. W. Kendrick, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is L. W. Kendrick. I am 72 years of age and have lived in and near the Dogwood community all of my life and have all along been well acquainted with the following described lot:

A lot in Dogwood described as follows: Beginning at a point where the east line of Brierfield, Blocton & Birmingham, now Southern Railway crosses the Tuscaloosa road; thence north along the right of way of said railroad to the corner of the former W. E. Harrison lot; thence east to within 50 feet of the Dunnam lot; thence south to the said Tuscaloosa Road; thence west along said road to the point of beginning, being a part of the $\frac{1}{4}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 22, Range # West, except highway right of way; situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

I remember the above lot when it was owned by W. P. Williams about the year 1922. After his death, his wife and heirs sold the lot to me about the year 1925 and I ran a little store on it while I had it for about a year and then I sold the same to Pete Heath for \$400.00. I recall that soon after he purchased it, I came to Columbiana with him to get a tax matter cleared up in connection with the land. Thereafter Pete Heath and Eldo C. Heath, who I understood were partners, operated a store for a number of years on the lot. The deed which I obtained from W. P. Williams was lost and never recorded.


