Personally came and appeared before the undersigned authority, a Notary Public in and for said County in said State, L. W. Hobbs, who after being first by me duly sworn to speak the truth, deposeth and says:

My name is L. W. Hobbs, and I am 40 years of age and reside at Wilsonville, Alabama. I am familiar with the ownership and possession of the following described property:

The West one-half of the Northwest quarter and the North twenty-five acres of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and the North twenty-five acres of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 20 South, Range 2 East.

Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

I own property within a distance of approximately one mile from the above described property. I have had personal knowledge of the ownership and possession of the above described property for the past 20 years or more. In fact when I was 13 years of age I worked cutting timber off the above described property for use as telephone poles. At that time Will Holley and his wife Jessie Holley were in possession of the above described property.

I have examined the deed of Will Holley to Jessie Holley dated January 29, 1934 and recorded in Deed Book 94 at page 231 in the Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and this deed contains an erroneous description of the property and that "The North 20 acres off the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 20, Range 2 East" should have been "The North 25 acres off the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 18, Township 20, Range 2 East."

I know of my own personal knowledge that Will Holley and his wife Jessie Holley have claimed and possessed the above described property for the past 20 years and that their possession of the property for the past 20 years was continuous, exclusive, peaceful, quiet, notorious, direct, adverse and under color of title and claim of ownership and that no one has been in possession of any part of said property claiming adverse to said ownership, nor have I known of any one claiming any right, title, or interest in or to said property, adverse to said ownership, nor have I ever heard of any one disputing or questioning said ownership to said property.
