

RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED FOR PUBLIC ROAD

STATE OF ALABAMA

Shelby County

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, _____

_____ and wife _____ of the County and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by Shelby County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for the further consideration of the benefit accruing to us and to the public from the construction or improvement of a public road through our lands, in Shelby County, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, its successors or assigns, a Right-of-way hereinafter described, over and across our said lands in Shelby County, Alabama, for a public road; which right-of-way shall be

See below _____ feet in width on _____ side of the center line of said road, as it is now located and staked out by the Highway Department or as much of our lands as is required to make a _____ foot right-of-way across our lands, said right-of-way herein conveyed being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: And as shown on the right-of-way map of Project No. CP3-70 as recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County.

Parcel I. Beginning at a point on the centerline of Project CP3-70 at Station 30+77, the west property line, being also a point on the south property line; thence east along the south property line a distance of 190', more or less, to a point 40' left of Station 32+50; thence northwesterly along the 40' right of way line of said project a distance of 193', more or less, to a point on the west property line; thence south along the west property line a distance of 41' to the point of beginning.

Said parcel of land is lying in the SW 1/4 of SE 1/4, Sec. 25, T 20 S, R 3 W and contains 0.09 acre, more or less, including that part now occupied by the present road.

Parcel II. Beginning at a point 40' left of Station 36+30, of said project; being a point in the center of the present dirt road; thence southeasterly along the center of the dirt road a distance 100', more or less, to a point on the centerline of said project at Station 37+50, thence southeasterly along the centerline of said project along a 6° curve to the left a distance of 225.7' to the point of ending of the curvature of the centerline; thence S 86° 55' E along the centerline of said project a distance of 304.3' to the point of ending at Station 42+80, the east property line.

Said parcel of land being 40' wide on the left (north) side of centerline of said project and is lying in the NW 1/4 of NE 1/4, Sec. 36, T 20 S, R 3 W and contains 0.54 acres, more or less, including that part now occupied by the present road.

All agreements, covering the moving, relocating and/or changing of the building and/or structures located wholly or partially on the above described right-of-way shall be in writing and approved by the State Highway Department before same shall be valid and binding on the said State Highway Department. The grantor hereby grants permission with right of ingress and egress to grantor's adjoining property at any time during construction period of project for purpose of moving grantor's buildings and/or structures from the above described right-of-way.
