Obie J. Littleton and wife, Janette M. Littleton

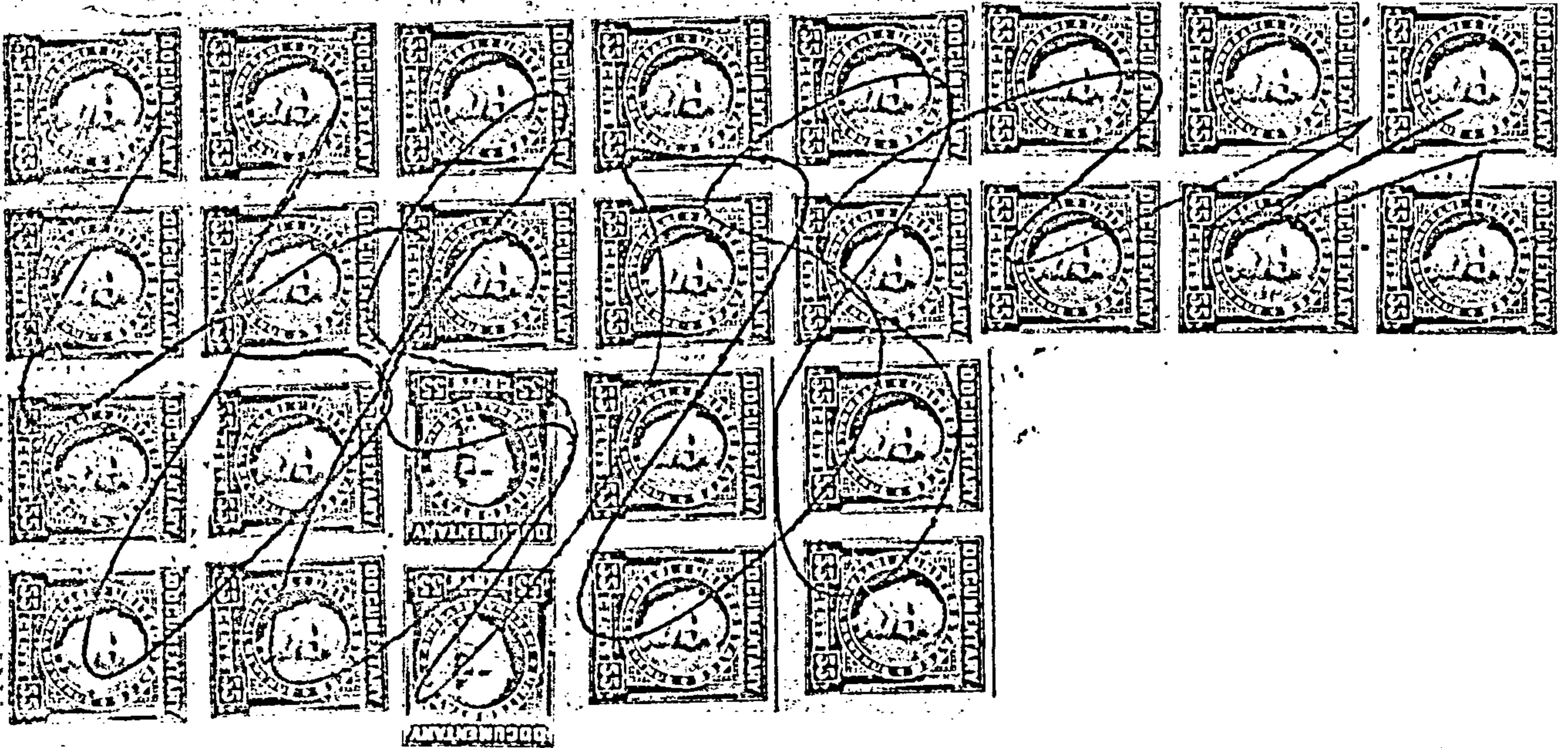
(herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto
