Personally appeared before me, the undersigned authority, Leslie I. Newton and wife, Mary Newton, who being by me first duly sworn deposes and says as follows:



The fences as presently located on the lands are in the same position as they were when we purchased from Mr. Tatum.

Further deponents saith not.


