Stevenson and wife, Alma Agee Stevenson, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed to various parties certain seams of coal located in portions of the lands covered by the aforesaid deed from The Alabama State Land Company, subject to the reservation of certain rights and interests as set forth in said deeds, reference is here made to said deeds for all purposes; said deeds herein referred to shall hereinafter be called collectively for purposes of reference only as "said Coal Deeds" and are the following:

and wife, Alma Agee Stevenson, their heirs and assigns, do hereby covenant with the said Wesley West, his heirs and assigns, that they are lawfully seized in fee of the said lands and interests in lands, that they have good right to sell and convey the same, and that they will warrant and defend the said lands and interests in lands to the said Wesley West, his heirs and assigns, forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof by, through or under the said P. M. Stevenson and wife, Alma Agee Stevenson, and no further.
