I, Linnie Pratt Crowe, a resident of Shelby County, Alabama, over twenty-one years of age, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish this my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills heretofore made by me.

FIRST: I will that all my debts and funeral expenses shall be paid by my Executor or Executors as soon after my death as practicable.

SECOND: I will unto Ione Crowe Guerard my home in Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama. I have previously advanced my son, Aldrich C. Crowe, the sum of \$3,000.00.

THIRD: I will, devise and bequeath all the rest and residue of my property, both real and personal, to my two children, Ione Crowe Guerard and Aldrich C. Crowe, share and share alike.

FOURTH: It is my will and desire that should either one of my children die before the probate of this Will, that his or her descendants should take their parents part of my estate.

FIFTH: I further will and desire that should my only two children and their descendants die before this Will is offered for probate, then my estate to go to my next of kin then living.

SIXTH: I nominate and appoint my daughter, Ione Crowe Guerard as the Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament, and should she fail or refuse to act for any reason, then I appoint my son, Aldrich C. Crowe, as Executor; provided also that should my daughter desire to have my son cooperate with her, then, and in that event I nominate both of them and declare that she, or they shall not be required to give any bond for the performance of her or their duty arising hereunder; nor shall they be required to make any inventory of the property coming into their hands, nor

make any report to any court of their proceedings hereunder.
