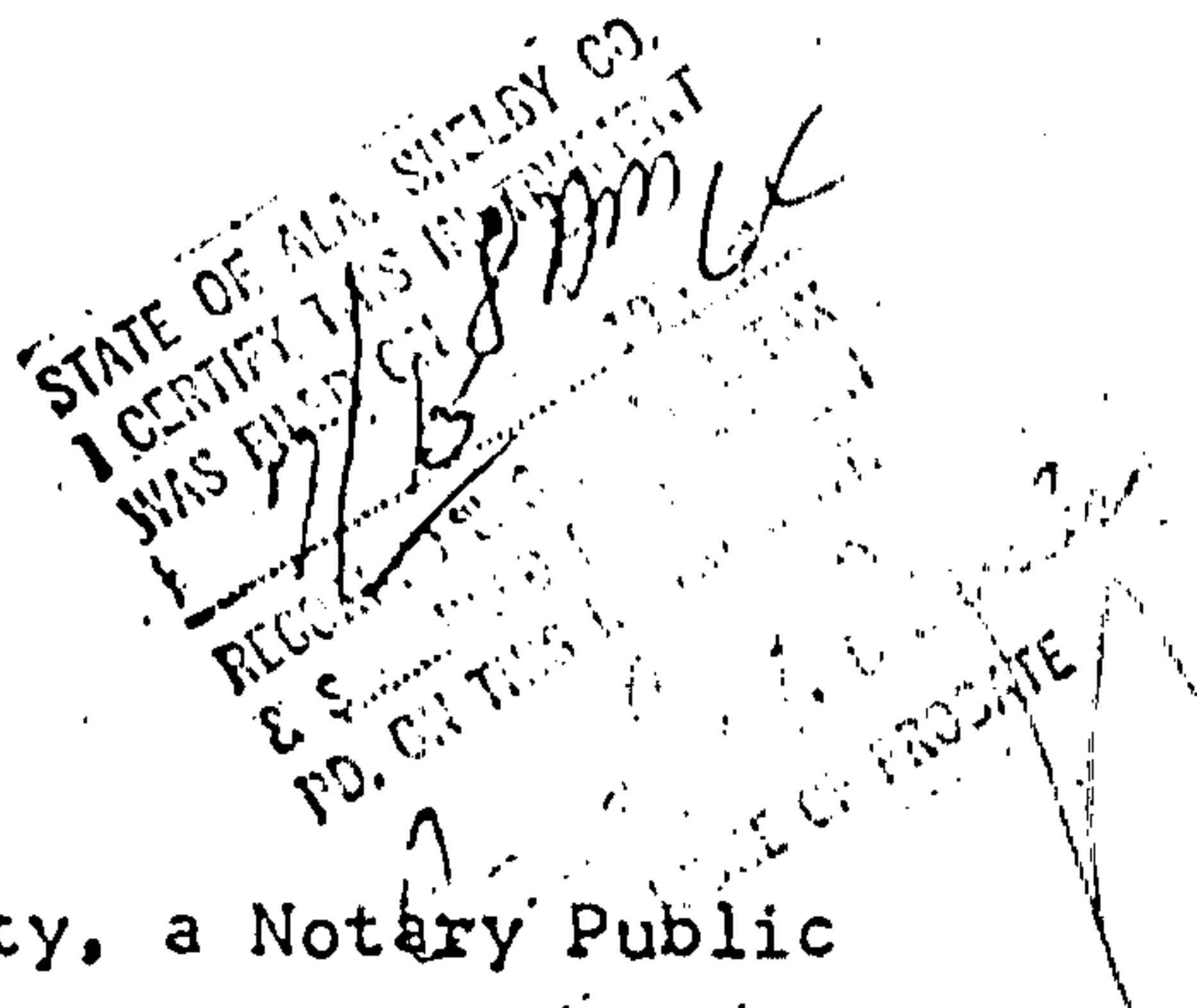


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AFFIDAVIT

STATE OF ALABAMA

Before me, the undersigned authority, a Notary Public for the State of Alabama at Large, personally appeared F. F. Mullins, who, known to me, being sworn, upon oath deposes and states as follows:

I am a resident of Helena, Shelby County, Alabama, and have been a resident of Helena, Alabama for more than forty years.

I have paid taxes on the following described property for more than ten years:

Part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 20 Range 3 West, more particularly described as follows: From the intersection of the south line of the L & N Railroad right of way and the centerline of Prairie Branch, run East along said south line of the railroad right of way for 1126.0 feet to a point of beginning, thence right 101 degrees 30' and southerly for 1010 feet, thence left 90 degrees 21' and East for 302.27 feet to the West line of a proposed 50 foot county road right of way, thence left 103 degrees 45' and north along said proposed West right of way line for 303.69 feet, thence right 12 degrees 53' and north along said proposed west right of way line for 295.02 feet, thence right 4 degrees 37' and north along said proposed west right of way line and a northerly extension of said right of way line for 470.3 feet, more or less, to the south line of said L & N Railroad right of way, thence left 104 degrees 54' and West along said railroad right of way for 255 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning. Situated in Shelby County, Alabama

For more than forty years I have claimed the said property and have treated it as my own. I have had the said property fenced, grazed my cattle upon it, plowed it, sowed it and harvested hay therefrom, cut trees down that were growing on it and otherwise treated it as my own for more than the last past twenty years.

For more than the last past twenty years I have had uninterrupted, continuous, peaceful, open, hostile, notorious and adverse possession of the said above described property.
