who, known to me, being sworn, did upon oath depose and say  
as follows:

I am a resident of the State of Alabama and live in  
Shelby County. I am personally acquainted with F. F. Mullins  
and have known him for much longer than 20 years. I am also  
acquainted with the following described tract of land:

Part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, Township 20 Range 3 West,  
more particularly described as follows: From the  
intersection of the south line of the L & N Rail-  
road right of way and the centerline of Prairie  
Branch, run East along said south line of the rail-  
road right of way for 1126.0 feet to a point of  
beginning, thence right 101 degrees 30' and southerly  
for 1010 feet, thence left 90 degrees 21' and East  
for 302.27 feet to the West line of a proposed 50 foot  
county road right of way, thence left 103 degrees 45'  
and north along said proposed West right of way line  
for 303.69 feet, thence right 12 degrees 53' and  
north along said proposed west right of way line for  
295.02 feet, thence right 4 degrees 37' and north  
along said proposed west right of way line and a  
northerly extension of said right of way line for  
470.3 feet, more or less, to the south line of said  
L & N Railroad right of way, thence left 104 degrees  
54' and West along said railroad right of way for  
255 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.  
Situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

I personally know that Mr. F. F. Mullins has had possession  
of the above described property for more than the last past twenty  
years and that he has at all times treated it as his property.  
He has fenced the said property and cut timber from it. He has  
grazed his cattle upon it and he has grown crops on the said  
land.
