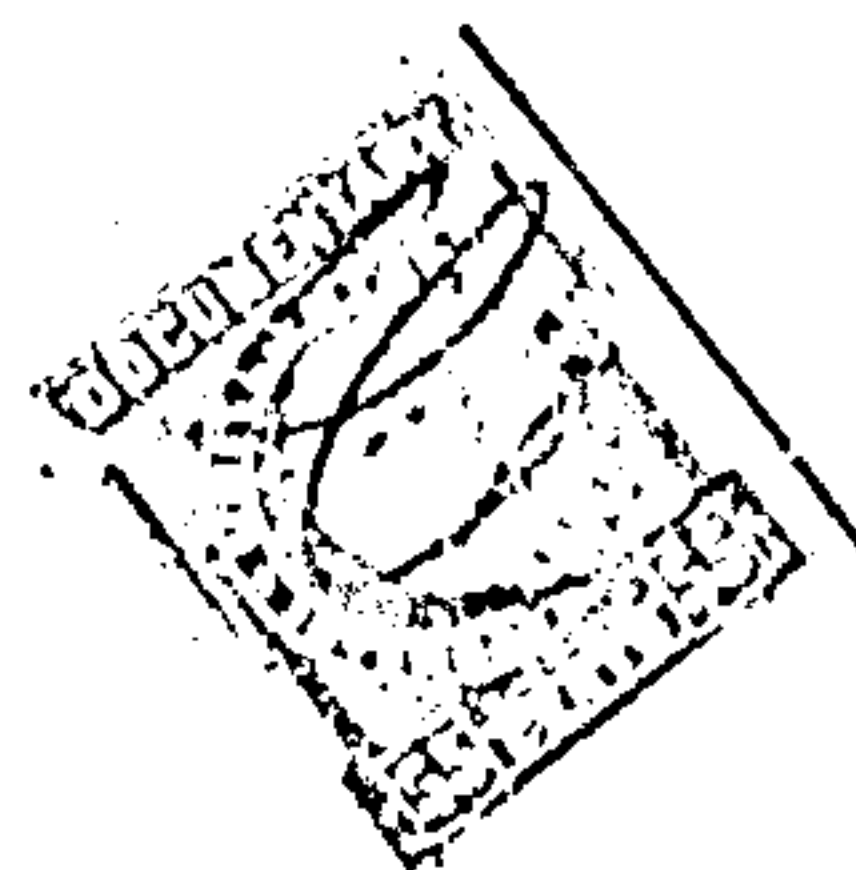
do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said L. RAY WHITE & WIFE JOYCE MELTON WHITE
