DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE.

IN THE SHELBY COUNTY LAW AND EQUITY COURT
IN EQUITY, CASE NO. 573

This cause coming on to be heard upon the verified petition of Ethel Washington mother of George Washington for the removal of the disabilities of non-age of the said George Washington, this being the day set by a former order of this Court to hear and determine said petition:

Now comes the petitioner, and the testimony of the witnesses having been taken by affidavit pursuant to the direction of the Court as noted by the Register, and the Court finding that the facts stated in the said petition are true; that the said Ethel Washington resides in Alabaster, Shelby County, Alabama; that the said George Washington resides with petitioner; that the father of the said George Washington is dead and that the said George Washington, is over the age of 18 years and will reach his twenty-first birthday in, to-wit, August of 1967, and the Court being satisfied that it will be to the best interest of said minor to be relieved from the disabilities of non-age, and no objection being filed to the granting of said petition, it is, therefore,

CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the prayer of said petition be and hereby is granted; that it will be to the interest of the said minor, George Washington, to be relieved from the disabilities of non-age unconditionally and without restriction.

It is further CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED That the said George Washington be and hereby is relieved from the disabilities of non-age unconditionally and without restriction and that she be and hereby is invested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, buy, sell and convey real estate and generally to do and perform all acts which she could lawfully do if twenty-one years of age; that a duly certified copy of this decree be filed for record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama; that the petitioner pay the costs in this behalf incurred.
