PETITION FOR CHANGE OF NAME

IN THE PROBATE COURT OF

SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA

TO THE HONORABLE CONRAD M. FOWLER, JUDGE OF SAID COURT:

1. Now comes John Elmo Sandusky, who is also known as John Elmo Weas, and respectfully shows unto the Court that he is a white male and has been a bona fide resident citizen of Shelby County, Alabama, for the past five or more years, presently residing at P. O. Box 418, Calera, Alabama, and that he is over the age of twenty-one years, his birthday being February 17, 1934, and his place of birth being at McLeansboro, Hamilton County, State of Illinois.

Petitioner further shows that his Father's name was Elmo Sandusky and his Mother's maiden name was Lucille Nelson; that his Mother and Father were divorced subsequent to Petitioner's birth, and that Petitioner remained in the custody of his Mother after said divorce; that Petitioner's Mother remarried Walter Weas when Petitioner was a small child, and that Petitioner has been generally known by the name "John Elmo Weas" since he was, to wit, about three years old.

Petitioner further shows that his social security no. is 391-30-5389 and that his current drivers license no. is 1831982.

Petitioner further shows that he is married to Evelyn Anna Cottier (Weas) and that he has two children, a daughter, Donna Kaye (Weas), and a son, David Lynn (Weas).

2. That Petitioner's certificate of birth from Hamilton County, Illinois, shows his name to be John Elmo Sandusky.

3. That your Petitioner now desires to have his name legally changed from John Elmo Sandusky to John Elmo Weas and to be known henceforth by the name of John Elmo Weas alone.

WHEREFORE in pursuance of the provisions of the Code 1940, Title 13, Section 278, the said John Elmo Sandusky files this his declaration in writing, signed by him, declaring that henceforth his name will be John Elmo Weas.

Your Petitioner prays that the Court will make such order in the premises as may be proper to change his name.
