Begin at the southwest corner of the South half of the NE¹/₄ of Section 2, Township 24 Range 13 East and run 180 feet north; thence 135 feet east; thence south 180 feet; thence west 135 feet to point of beginning.

The above named grantors and grantee being the sole and surviving heirs at law of L. R. Martin, deceased.
