Johnson who signed the deed as secretary of Buck Creek Cotton Mills, a corporation to R. L. Pope, dated ~~Dec~~ January 20, 1940 and recorded in Deed Book 109 at page 178 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama.

I knew R. L. Pope, the grantee in said deed, who died on or about January 12, 1960 and first became acquainted with him in the 1930's when he moved to Shelby County from Talladega County, Alabama, and was a supervisor in the Buck Creek Cotton Mill from the 1930's until his retirement in the late 1950's.

When I first became acquainted with Mr. R. L. Pope in the 1930's, he was married to Grace Irene Pope and to my knowledge there was one child born of the previous marriage of R. L. Pope and Ella Reeves, whose name was Hazel, and Grace Irene Pope had a child by the name of Elizabeth Hughes who was born to the first marriage of Grace Irene Pope.

To my knowledge Hazel Pope, who was first married to Floyd Brown and is presently married to George French Luncum is the sole ^{surviving} heir at law of R. L. Pope.
