Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 2d, 1850,
entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military
Service of the United States," Warrant No. 20,000, for 160 acres,
issued in favor of William Edmonds, private in Captain Ward's
Third Company, Georgia Battalion,

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the
South half of the North East fractional quarter of Section seventeen,
and the South half of the North West fractional quarter of Section
twenty, in Township twenty-one, of Range two, West, in the District
of Land subject to entry at Savannah, Arkansas, containing
one hundred and sixty acres, and fifty-one hundredths of an acre,
according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by
the SURVEYOR GENERAL; which has been signed unto William Butler.

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said

The tract of Land aforesaid: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances
thereto, unto the said William Butler, and to his

heirs and assigns forever.
