Whereas, In pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved September 28th, 1850, entitled "An Act granting Bounty Land to certain Officers and Soldiers who have been engaged in the Military Service of the United States," Warrant No. 10,004 for 160 acres.

Issued in favor of: *William Edmonds, private in Captain's Magazine & Heavy Company, Georgia Militia, War 1812.*

has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South Half of the North East fractional quarter of Section number one, and the South Half of the North West fractional quarter of Section twenty, in Townships twenty-two, of Range ten, West, in the District of Land subject to sale at Tusculum, Alabama, containing one hundred and fifty acres, and fifty nine hundredths of one acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: which has been assigned unto *Hiram Butler*

Now know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *Hiram Butler*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Hiram Butler, and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I, *Franklin Pierce*, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
