KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That I, Mary Lee Bronaugh, a resident of Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby expressly revoking any and all former wills heretofore made by me.

ITEM I

I hereby direct that all of my just debts, including the expense of my last illness and funeral be paid out of my estate as soon as practicable after my death.

ITEM II

If he survives me, I hereby devise and bequeath to my beloved husband, A. C. Bronaugh, all of the property, both real and personal, which I may own at the time of my death, wherever situated, unconditionally.

If my husband does not survive me, or if we die as a result of a common disaster within 30 days of each other, then I give and bequeath unto my godchild, Cynthia Spain, (the daughter of Margery Phillips Spain, now residing at Sumiton, Alabama) all of the personal jewelry which I may own at the time of my death and I give and bequeath all of the silver, china, linens, household furnishings and clothing which I may own at the time of my death to my godchildren, Catharine Vance and Vivian Vance, (the daughters of Mr. and Mrs. Hillard C. Vance, now residing at Moulton, Alabama), in equal shares, and I devise and bequeath all of the real estate which I may own at the time of my death, wherever situated, and

ITEM III

I hereby nominate and appoint my husband, A. C. Bronaugh, as the executor of this my last will and testament, and I hereby direct that he be not required to give bond for the performance of his office as executor and hereby direct that he be not required to file inventories, appraisals , or accountings of any kind to the court. In the event my husband, A. C. Bronaugh, predeceases me or in the event we die as a result of a common disaster within 30 days of each other, then in that event I hereby nominate and appoint as alternate executor, my son, John F. Bronaugh. My alternate executor shall have the same powers and exemptions as those granted to my primary executor.
