Before me, *L. D. Kewally*, the undersigned authority in and for said County in said State, personally appeared G. H. Ozley, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is G. H. Ozley. I am 67 years of age. I was born on land which, along with the hereinafter described land, was a part of the Wesley Ozley farm. Said land being described as follows:

The E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, being 20 acres, more or less;
The E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south 10 acres of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 21 South, Range 2 West, being 5 acres;
All being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant says he does not recall exactly when his father purchased part of the above described land as shown by deed from Callie Jones made in 1904 and recorded in Deed Book 27 page 309, but from the time affiant can first remember, he knows his father purchased a part of the land from Callie Jones. Affiant further says he does not remember the occasion, but knows it is common knowledge in his family that Wesley Ozley purchased the remainder of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, being the northerly portion of the same from W. L. Garrett in 1903, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 28 page 502 in said Probate Office. Affiant further says regarding the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the south 10 acres of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 8 that affiant recalls his father purchased the same from W. L. Garrett in 1903, as mentioned above, and recalls his father went into possession of both of said tracts, cleared it, farmed it and planted corn and cotton on it all of his life until his death in 1943. At which time the same was willed to affiant and affiant refenced the entire tract and used the same for pasture and raised cattle on it from the time he same was willed to him until the past two year and since that time, affiant has rented the same to Dewey Garrett who has used it for pasture until this very day. Affiant says throughout all the years the same has been under fence from the time he remembers it to the present time and he has never heard of anyone contesting his title or disputing his possession or that of his predecessors in title.

Affiant further says there has been called to his attention a deed from J. W. Hale and D. A. Hale to A. A. Roebuck dated September 23, 1911, recorded in Deed Book 45 page 461 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Affiant says he knows of his own knowledge that none of said persons ever owned any interest in the above described land, but they did own some land approximately

one-quarter of a mile away and affiant says clearly there was just an error in the description of the deed mentioned in this paragraph.
