My name is Mamie Ray Green. I am 74 years of age and have lived near and within a few miles of the following described land all of my life. Said land being described as follows:

Begin at the SW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 17, Township 20 South, Range 1 East and run north along west line 1193 feet to center of Wall Farm road, as it was located in September 1958, thence run east along said Wall road 372 feet; thence run south and parallel with the west line of said forty acres 1193 feet; thence run west along the south line of said forty acres 372 feet to the point of beginning; being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

J. R. Ray was my grandfather and I recall he died in the year 1920. I am informed J. R. Ray made a deed to Richard R. Ray in 1918 covering the above land. I know that Richard R. Ray went into immediate possession of the land as the owner of it and lived in a house situated on adjoining land and used the above land as a pasture and the same was fenced, along with other land for several years and until he sold it to T. M. Dennis and Martha Dennis in 1921. The Dennis went into possession of the farm and lived in a house on land adjoining the above and cultivated portions of their farm, but used the above for a pasture each and every year until they sold the same to Jannie M. Green in 1927, she being affiant's sister. The said Jannie M. Green and her husband, L. B. Green, who is a brother to my husband, went into immediate possession of the land and continued to use it in the same manner as had their predecessors and continued to pay taxes on said land each and every year until they sold the same to A. M. Muncy in April of 1945. A. M. Muncy went into immediate possession of said land and continued to use the same for pasture purposes and to pay taxes on it until he sold it in 1949 to O. B. Foster. The said O. B. Foster went into possession of the land and continued to use it for pasture purposes and paid the taxes until he sold the same to E. B. Capps and Louise Capps in 1958 as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 195 page 469 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Mr. & Mrs. Capps went into immediate possession of the above described land and put a dwelling house on the property and have been living on it each and every year and have been in possession of the same continuously to this very day. I have never heard of anyone contesting the possession of or disputing the title of E. B. Capps and Louise Capps or their predecessors in title.
