FIRST: My Will is that all my just debts and funeral expenses shall, by my Executrix, hereinafter named, be paid out of my estate as soon after my decease as convenient.

SECOND; I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, MARY BAMA SHAW, all my personal property, all my real property, all my mixed property, of which I shall die seized and possessed, or to which I may be entitled to at the time of my death, to be hers absolutely.

THIRD; I do nominate and appoint my beloved wife, MARY BAMA SHAW, to be the Executrix of this My Last Will and Testament.

FOURTH; My Executrix shall not be required to give any Bond, as such Executrix, to any Court. My Executrix shall not be required to make any Inventory of my estate to any Court, or make any final settlement of my estate, as such Executrix, to any Court.
