I, Henry F. Robertson, of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty-one years, and of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament.

1. I hereby direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my executrix, hereinafter provided for, as soon after my death as is practicable.

2. I hereby give, devise and bequeath unto my wife, Annie L. Robertson, all my property of every kind and description, whether real, personal or mixed and wherever situated, which I may possess at the time of my death, or to which I may have an equity. To have and to hold absolute and in fee simple.

3. I hereby nominate and appoint my said wife, Annie L. Robertson, as executrix of this my last will and testament, and hereby relieve her of the obligation of making bond, or of accounting to any Court or individual as to how she has executed this trust.
