## AFFIDAVIT

## KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

I, Bula Adams, after having been duly sworn to speak the truth, deposeth as follows:

I am Bula Adams, widow of Eugene Adams who died intestate in Shelby County, Alabama on September 27, 1951.
