As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, Grantors, for themselves and for their heirs and assigns, covenant and agree with Granton, its successors and assigns, that no improvements which are used or which are designed or intended to be used for habitation by persons or animals shall ever hereafter be constructed on that portion of the lands subject to the flood easement hereby granted and lying between clevations 397 and 398 feet above the mean sea level heretofore mentioned as such area is subject to flooding from time to time, and that Grantors shall, and their heirs and assigns will remove or cause to be removed from such area any such improvements which are now or may hereafter be located on such area. Grantors and Granton further covenant and agree that the foregoing covenant and agreement touches, benefits and concerns both the lands hereby conveyed and the lands adjoining same owned by Grantors, that such covenant and agreement is intended to run aidd shall run with the land and shall be binding upon Grantors, their heirs and assigns, forever.
