BROWN, JR. and wife, MARY LEE GARRETT BROWN, in hand paid by EXCHANGE SECURITY BANK, Birmingham, Alabama, and MARY LEE GARRETT BROWN, as Trustees under trust agreement for the benefit of PAMELA SUE BROWN executed by Jadie A. Brown, Jr. on December 28, 1962 the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we the said J. A. BROWN and wife, MARY LEE GARRETT BROWN, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said EXCHANGE SECURITY BANK and MARY LEE GARRETT BROWN as Trustees under trust agreement for the benefit of PAMELA SUE BROWN executed by Jadie A. Brown, Jr. on December 28, 1962, an undivided one-third (1/3) interest in and to the following real property, together with all improvements, hereditaments and appurtenances, located in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

A part of Fractional NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 3, Township 24 North, Range 12 East described as follows: Beginning at a common corner of property formerly belonging to Southern Railway Co. and property of W. L. Brown on the Southerly boundary of Old Columbiana-Centreville Road, said corner being located 470.1 feet measured along Southerly boundary of said road from intersection with the Easterly boundary of Shelby Street (60 feet wide); and running thence North 75 deg. 57' East along Southerly boundary of said Columbiana-Centreville Road a distance of 208.89 feet to NW corner of R. B. Galloway property; thence South 16 deg. 38' East along dividing line between property of said Railroad and Galloway a distance of 161.04 feet to a corner located 50 feet distant Northwardly from center line of Southern Railway main track measured at right angles thereto; thence Southwesterly, parallel to and 50 feet from center line of said main track a distance of 181.36 feet to W. 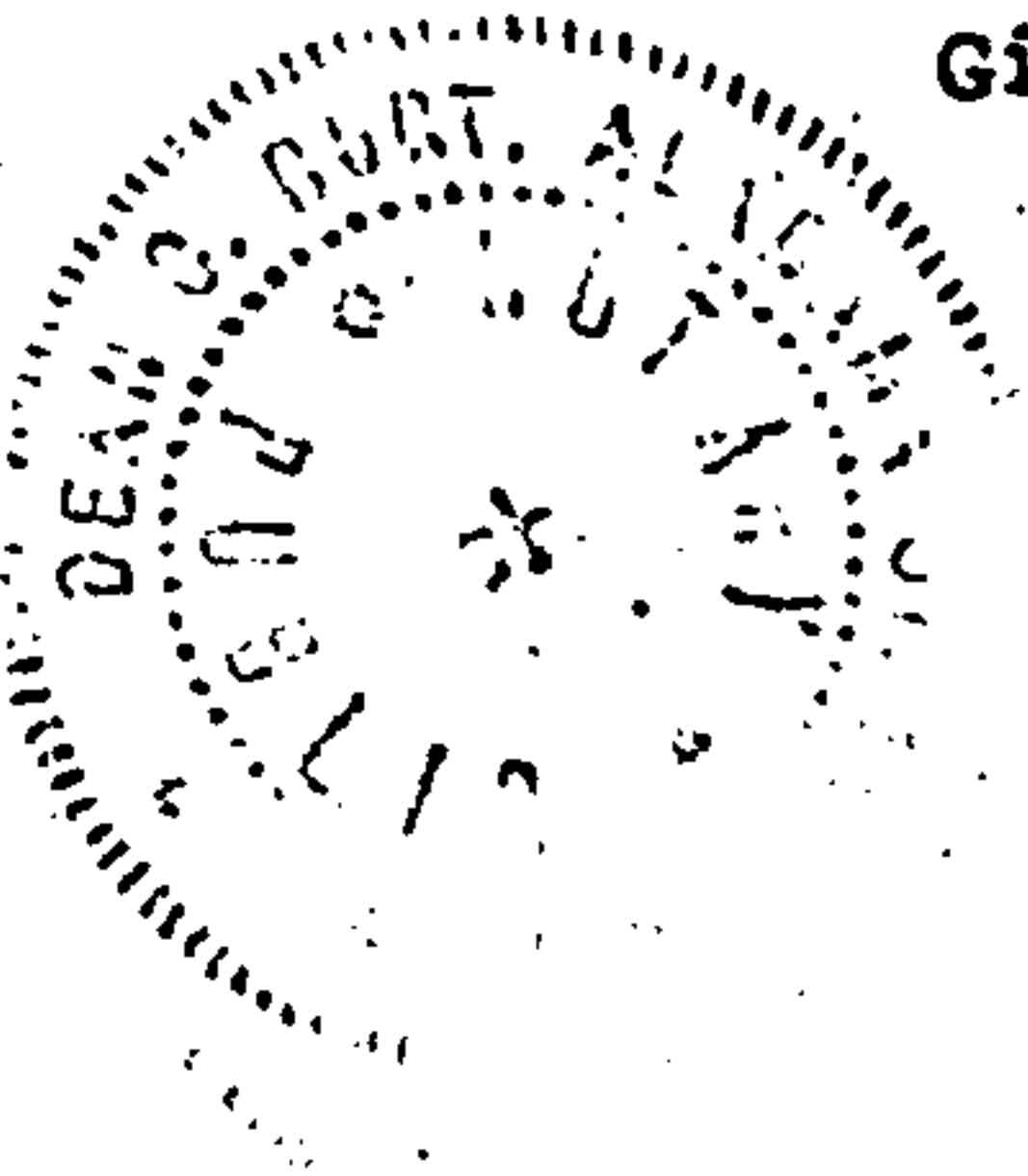
