and the section of the said *James H. Smith* is as follows: *Section 10, Township 36 North, Range 10 West, in the territory of Colorado.*

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been pur-

chased by the said *James H. Smith*.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several

Acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have Given and Granted, and, by these presents do give and grant, unto the said *James H. Smith*

the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appar-

tenances, of whatever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said *James H. Smith*

and *his heirs and assigns forever.*
