




Douglas, a certified Land Surveyor, hereby certify; the foregoing to be a true and correct map or plat of the following described property, situated in the N.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 - Section 11 - Township 19 South - Range 1 East. Commence, at an iron pipe, on the north line of said quarter-quarter, which is 210.0 feet, east of the N.E. corner and in a southerly direction and parallel to the west boundary line of said quarter-quarter, run a distance of 199.49 feet; thence, turn an angle of 90° 00' to the left for a distance of 525.0 feet, to the Point of Beginning; thence, turn an angle of 90° 00' to the right for a distance of 420.0 feet; thence, turn an angle of 90° 00' to the left for a distance of 176.02 feet; thence, turn an angle of 90° 00' to the left for a distance of 223.06 feet, to the north right of way line of the Public Road; thence, turn an angle of 7° 22' to the left along said right of way for a distance of 143.59 feet; thence, turn an angle of 6° 15' to the right along said right of way for a distance of 212.74 feet, to the agreed corner, between Charles Brasher and Lampkin Brasher; thence, turn an angle of 106° 25 1/2' to the left along the agreed line, between Charles Brasher and Lampkin Brasher for a distance of 872.08 feet; thence, turn an angle of 88° 28 1/2' to the left for a distance of 581.47 feet, to the Point of Beginning. I, hereby certify; that I, have located and placed iron pipes at the corners, and according to my survey there are no encroachments from the adjoining properties.
