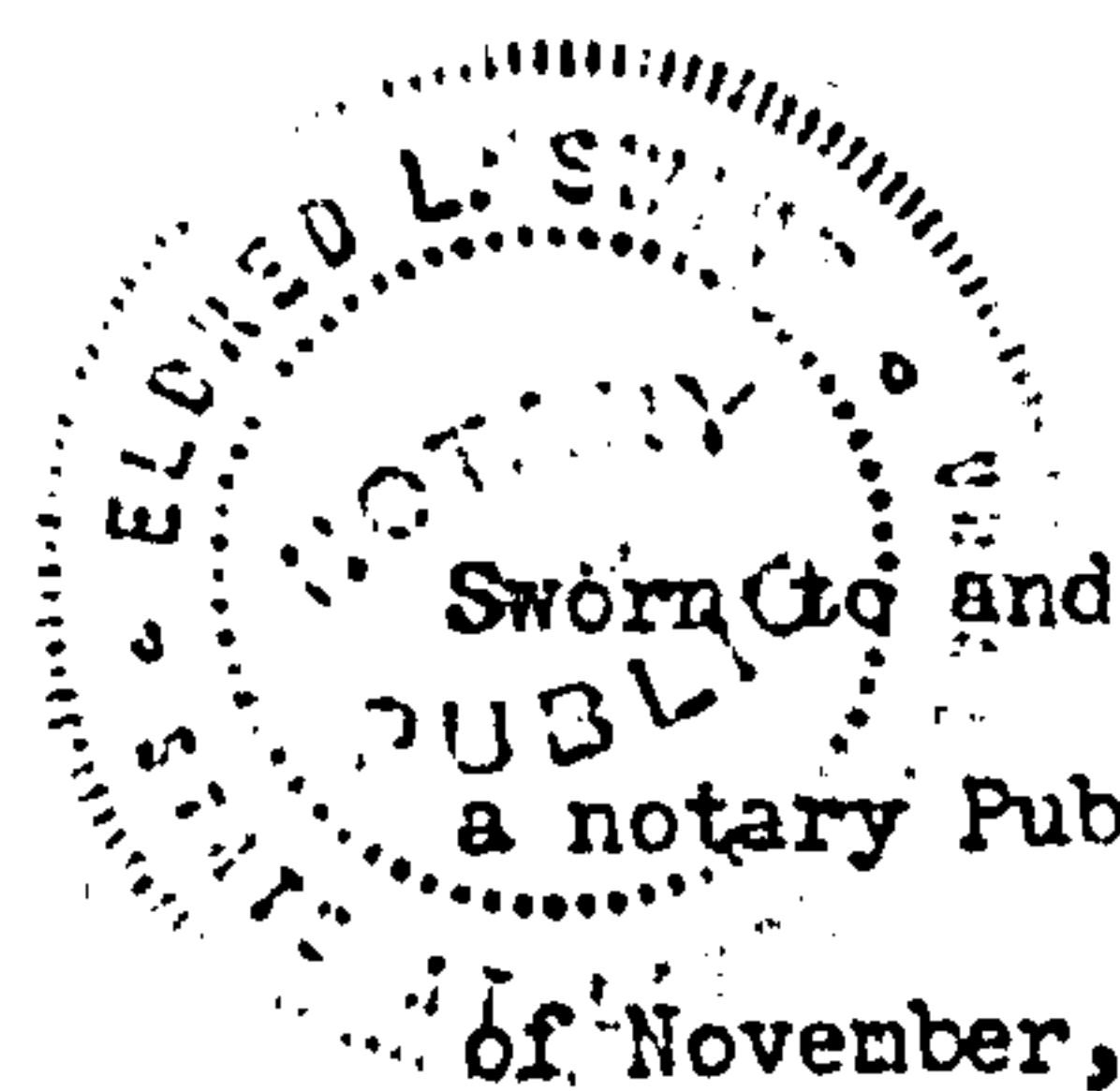
Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Oscar P. Wright, who first being by me duly sworn, on oath deposes and says: viz;

That he lives at Leeds, Alabama and that he has lived there for the past 45 years. That he was well acquainted with Henry A. Ragsdale, and that he became acquainted with them shortly after he came to Leeds, Alabama and continued to know them until the time of their deaths. That he knows that the said Henry A. Ragsdale and the wife Martha Ragsdale lived on and owned the following described property, to-wit:

A triangular shaped piece of land in the NW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , of Section 23, Township 17, Range 1, East, being all of that part of said Section of land lying North of road, known as Old Epperson Road, being more particularly described as follows: Begin at the NW corner of above said section and run East along said section line 670.8 feet, more or less, to old Epperson road, thence SW along said road to the West boundary line of said section line 330.5 feet, more or less, to point of beginning.

That he knows that the said Henry A. Ragsdale and the wife Martha Ragsdale had the active, open, peaceable, notorious and adverse possession of said land until 1942 at which time Luther P. Armstrong or his wife, Lillian Armstrong purchased said land from Martha Ragsdale the widow of Henry A. Ragsdale. That the said Martha Ragsdale died on or about the 23rd day of October, 1963.
