AFFIDAVIT

ST. CLAIR COUNTY

Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said County and State, personally appeared, Mary Elzanner Partridge, of lawful age, who, first being by me duly sworn, on oath deposes and says as follows:

My name is Mary Elzanner Partridge. I was formerly Mary Elzanner Brasher, my husband Olen Brasher having died on June 10, 1955, at Vandiver, Alabama. Thereafter I married Mr. Claude Partridge and we live at Branchville, Alabama. I married Olen Brasher on May 8, 1943, and there were no children born of our marriage. On March 28, 1946, Mr. John B. Whitfield and wife, N. B. Whitfield, conveyed to us by Warranty Deed the following described property:

A part of the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 10, 'i'own-ship 18 South, Range 1 East, described as follows:

Beginning at a point 105 yards west of the NE corner of the SE 1/4 of SW 1/4 of Section 10 and running south 105 yards; west 105 yards; north 105 yards to north line of said 1/4-1/4 section; thence east along north line, 105 yards to point of beginning

and this deed was executed and delivered on March 28, 1946, while my husband, Olen Brasher was living, who, as I have stated above, died many years later.

My husband died intestate with no issue, having never been married except to me and his mother and father were deceased also at the time of my husband's death and consequently the next of kin of my deceased husband were two brothers and two sisters, namely, Voyd Brasher, Douglas Brasher, Opal Patton and Avell Howard. My husband had no deceased brothers or sisters who had children.
