Whereas, George W. King of Dallas County Texas, has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Austin in said State, whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said George W. King of the Public Lands, for according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the East half of the South West quarter of Section thirty-two in Township twenty-five of Range one West in the District of Columbia, for sale at New Orleans. William Henry and his heirs and assigns do hereby certify that the said George W. King is entitled to the said land, according to the provisions of the said Act of Congress, and that the said land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said George W. King.

NOW KNOW YE, That the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA** in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said George W. King, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatever nature thereto belonging, unto the said George W. King, his heirs and assigns forever.
