John Mack Busby remarried after the death of Lizzie Busby, but there were no children born to that marriage, and Nancy Busby, who was the second wife, is now deceased.

I know of my own personal knowledge that after John Mack Busby acquired title to the property described in the deed referred to above that he moved on to said property with his family and lived there a year or two, but the property is erroneously described as being in the NE4 of NW4 of Section 11.
