DEED OF CORRECTION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That, WHEREAS, by deed dated November 2, 1948 and recorded in the Office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, at Vol. 136, Record of Deeds, Page 90, Buck Creek Cotton Mills, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Alabama, conveyed certain property to the Trustees of the Siluria Methodist Church, which said church, by change of name, subsequently became and is now known as Central Methodist Church; and,

WHEREAS, by deed dated and recorded in said Probate Office in Vol. 230 at page 431, Siluria Mills, Inc., an Alabama corporation, conveyed certain real property to said Central Methodist Church; and

WHEREAS, the descriptions contained in said deeds are erroneous; and

WHEREAS, Buck Creek Cotton Mills, by amended certificate of incorporation, has changed its name to Buck Creek Industries, Inc. and said corporation and Siluria Mills, Inc. and Central Methodist Church desire to correct said former deeds by the execution and delivery of this deed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES and for the purpose of correcting said former deeds hereinabove described, Buck Creek Industries, Inc. and Siluria Mills, Inc. hereby grant, bargain and convey to Central Methodist Church, its assigns and successors, all of their right, title and interest to the following described real property situated in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

That part of the S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 3 West, more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the NE corner of said S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 and running thence West along the North line of said S 1/2 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 844.7 feet; thence turn an angle to the left of 90 degrees and 12 minutes and run in a Southerly direction 249.24 feet to a monument; thence ^{turn} and an angle of 38 feet 40 minutes to the left, ^{and} run Southeasterly 340.09 feet to a point on the N.W. right of way line of Alabama Highway No. 119; thence run in a NE direction along said highway to the SW corner of that certain tract of land conveyed by Mr. T. C. Thompson to Vinzant, by deed executed in the year 1932 and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama; thence run in a NW direction along the SW line of said Vinzant property to the North line of said S 1/2 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4; thence run West along said North line of said S 1/2 of SW 1/4 of NE 1/4 to the point of beginning of the parcel hereby conveyed.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said property unto Siluria Mills, Inc. and Central Methodist Church, its assigns and successors forever.
