has been returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE, with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the *South East quarter of the North West quarter and the South half of the North East quarter of Section Twenty one and the South West quarter of the North West quarter of Section Twenty one in Township Twenty four of Range Fifteen East, in the District of Columbia subject to the claim of Frederick M. Ellinger containing One Hundred and fifty nine acres and Eighty six and three fourths hundredths of an acre* according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Lands returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL: *Which has been assigned to George D. Shortridge*

Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *George D. Shortridge*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *George D. Shortridge and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
