Now Know Ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said *George D. Sherridge*

the tract of Land above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *George D. Sherridge and to his*

heirs and assigns forever.
