

VACATION OF PUBLIC STREET

We, the undersigned John Garnett Lacey and wife, Lillian S. Lacey, being all of the owners of the lands abutting that certain street in the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, known as designated as Park Way Circle, as shown by map of the Plat of the 1st Addition to the J. G. Lacey Subdivision, as shown in Map Book 3 at page 146, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, do hereby join in this written instrument declaring said Park Way Circle to be vacated so as to destroy the force and effect of the dedication of said Park Way Circle by said Map recorded in Map Book 3 at page 146 in said Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and so as to divest all public rights, including any rights which may have been acquired by prescription, in and to said Park Way Circle.

Said Park Way Circle being located within the limits of the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, the assent of the Mayor and Council of the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, (being the governing body of said municipality) to the vacation of said Park Way Circle has been procured, as is evidenced by a resolution duly adopted by such governing body, ^{and} a copy of such resolution, certified by the Clerk of the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, the ^{ministerial} Officer in charge of the records of said municipality, is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and is by reference hereto made a part hereof, and is filed and recorded with this written declaration of vacation, as provided by Code of Alabama of 1940, Title 56, Section 16, as last recompiled and amended.

Convenient means of ingress and egress to and from their property has been afforded to all other property owners owning property in the tract of land embraced in said Map or Plat of said Subdivision recorded in Map Book 3 at page 146, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, either by the remaining streets and alleys, or by other streets or alleys which have subsequently been dedicated.

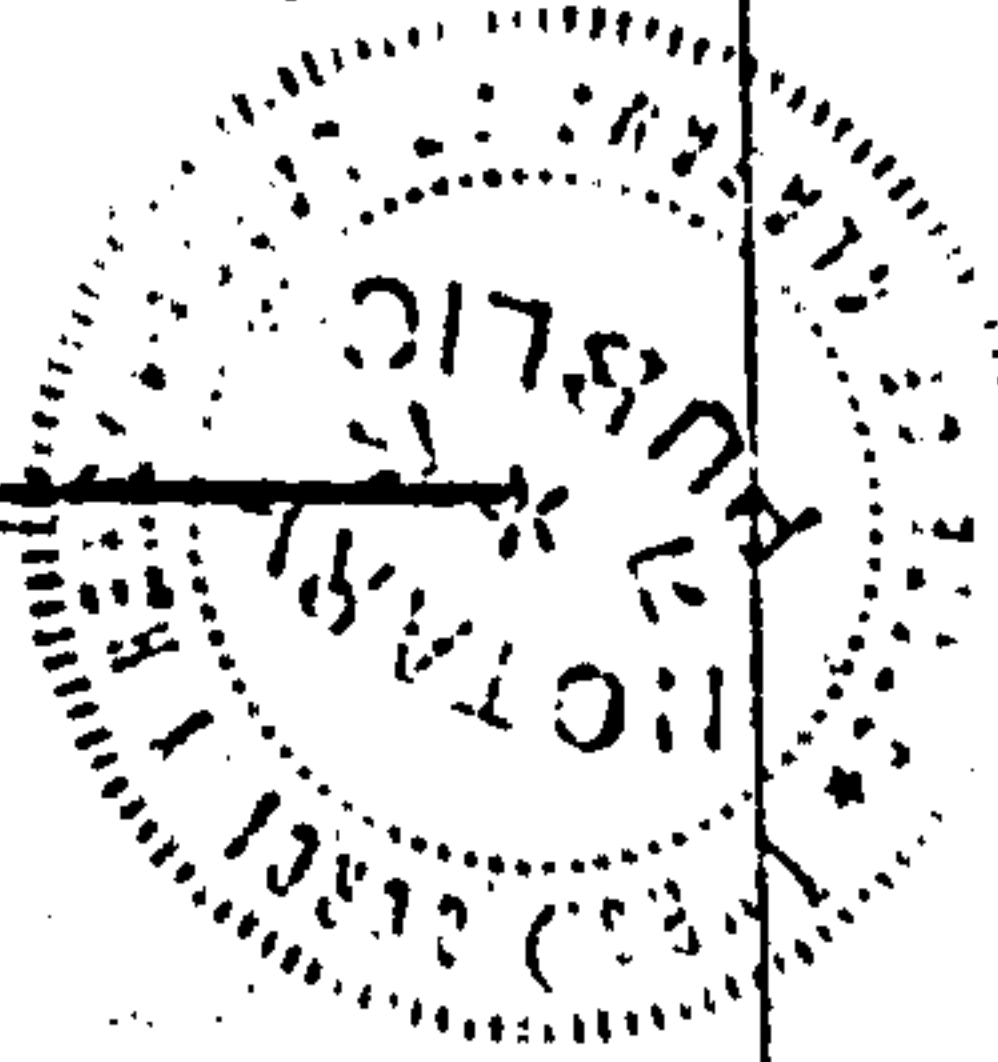

MINUTES FOR PASSAGE OF RESOLUTION
OF PERMANENT OPERATION

The following resolution of permanent operation, as follows:

"WHEREAS, Park Way Circle, as shown and designated by the Plat of the 1st Addition to the J. G. Lacey Subdivision, as recorded in Map Book 3 at page 146, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, has heretofore been dedicated as a public street, and

WHEREAS, said Park Way Circle is located and situated within the corporate limits of the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, and

WHEREAS, all of the owners of the lands abutting said Park Way Circle, being John Garnett Lacey and wife, Lillian S. Lacey, have joined in a written instrument declaring the same to be vacated, and

WHEREAS, convenient means of ingress and egress to and from their property has been afforded to all other property owners owning property in the tract of land embraced in the said map or plat recorded in Map Book 3 at page 146, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, either by the remaining streets and alleys dedicated by said map or plat, or by other streets or alleys which have been dedicated to the public use, and

WHEREAS, it is now desirable and expedient for the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, to join in and assent to the vacation of said Park Way Circle as a public street,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, and by the Mayor and Council thereof, being the governing body of said municipality, that said Town of Alabaster, Alabama, and said Mayor and Council thereof, do assent to the vacation of said Park Way Circle as a public street in and for the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, and that said Park Way Circle, and the area encompassed within the bounds thereof as shown by the Plat of the 1st Addition to the J. G. Lacey Subdivision as shown in Map Book 3 at page 146, Office of Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, be, and the same is hereby declared by the Town of Alabaster, Alabama, to be so vacated as a public street."

Was introduced by Councilman Rubin, at the regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Alabaster, Alabama,

on April 11, 1966, and the same having been read in full by the Clerk, it was moved by Councilman Douglas and seconded by Councilman Mathis that all rules governing the Town Council which might, unless suspended, prevent the passage and adoption of said resolution at this meeting, be and the same are hereby suspended, for the purpose of permitting the said resolution to be finally passed and adopted at this meeting.

Whereupon the Mayor put the question on said motion for the suspension of the rules and on roll call the vote was as follows: Voting yea, Mayor L. C. Payne, Councilman Douglas, Rubin, Mathis, Henry and Farris.

Voting nay, none.

Thereupon the Mayor declared said motion carried and the rules suspended. Councilman Rubin then moved that said resolution be now placed before the Council for its final passage. Councilman Farris seconded the motion.

The question being put upon the placing of said resolution before the Council for its final passage, the roll was called with the following results: Voting ays: Mayor L. C. Payne, Henry, Farris, Douglas, Rubin and Mathis, Councilman. Voting nay: None.

The Mayor declared the motion carried. Councilmen Farris thereupon moved that the said resolution be finally passed and adopted as introduced, Councilman Henry seconded the motion.

The question being put upon the final passage and adoption of said resolution, the roll was called with the following results: Voting ays: Mayor L. C. Payne, Henry, Farris, Douglas, Rubin and Mathis, Councilman. Voting nay: None.

The Mayor thereupon declared said motion carried and the resolution finally passed and adopted. The Mayor signed said resolution in approval thereof.
