Homestead Certificate No. 9529

Application 13021

Whereas there has been deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a CERTIFICATE of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery

Alabama , whereby it appears that pursuant to the Act of Congress of the 30th May, 1862, "To secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the public domain," and in accordance thereto, the claim of John Rushing was duly established and duly consummated in conformity to law for the East half of the North East quarter of Section four in Township twenty-four North of Range fifteen East of St. Stephens Meridian in Alabama containing Seventy three acres and twenty nine hundredths of an acre

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land returned to the GENERAL LAND OFFICE by the SURVEYOR GENERAL.

You know ye, That there is therefore granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said John Rushing the tract of land above described, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereto unto the said JOHN RUSHING and his heirs and assigns forever.
