Also one 1966 Ford station wagon, being the motor vehicle now in possession of Edith Grady Lovelady for her personal use.

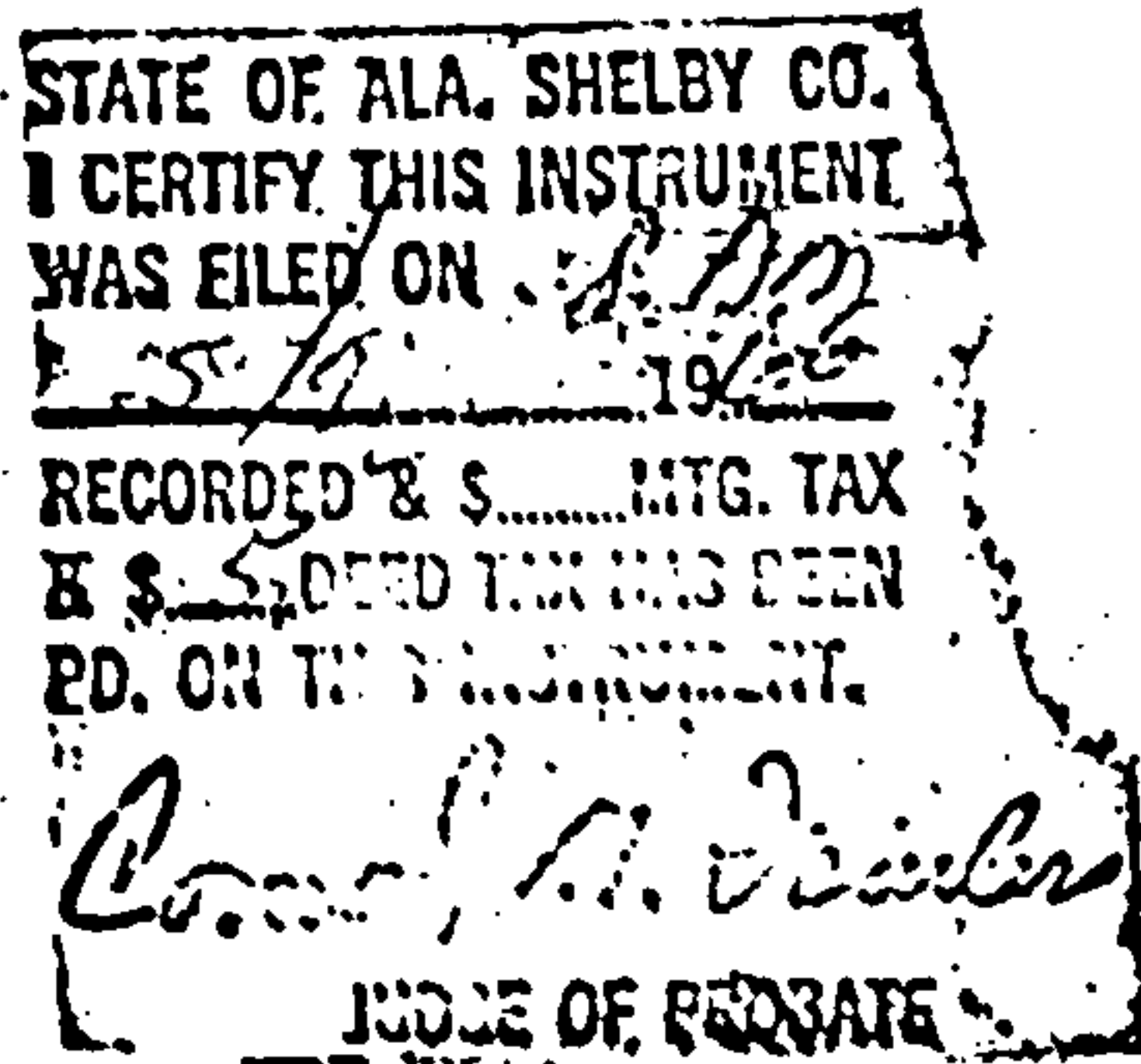
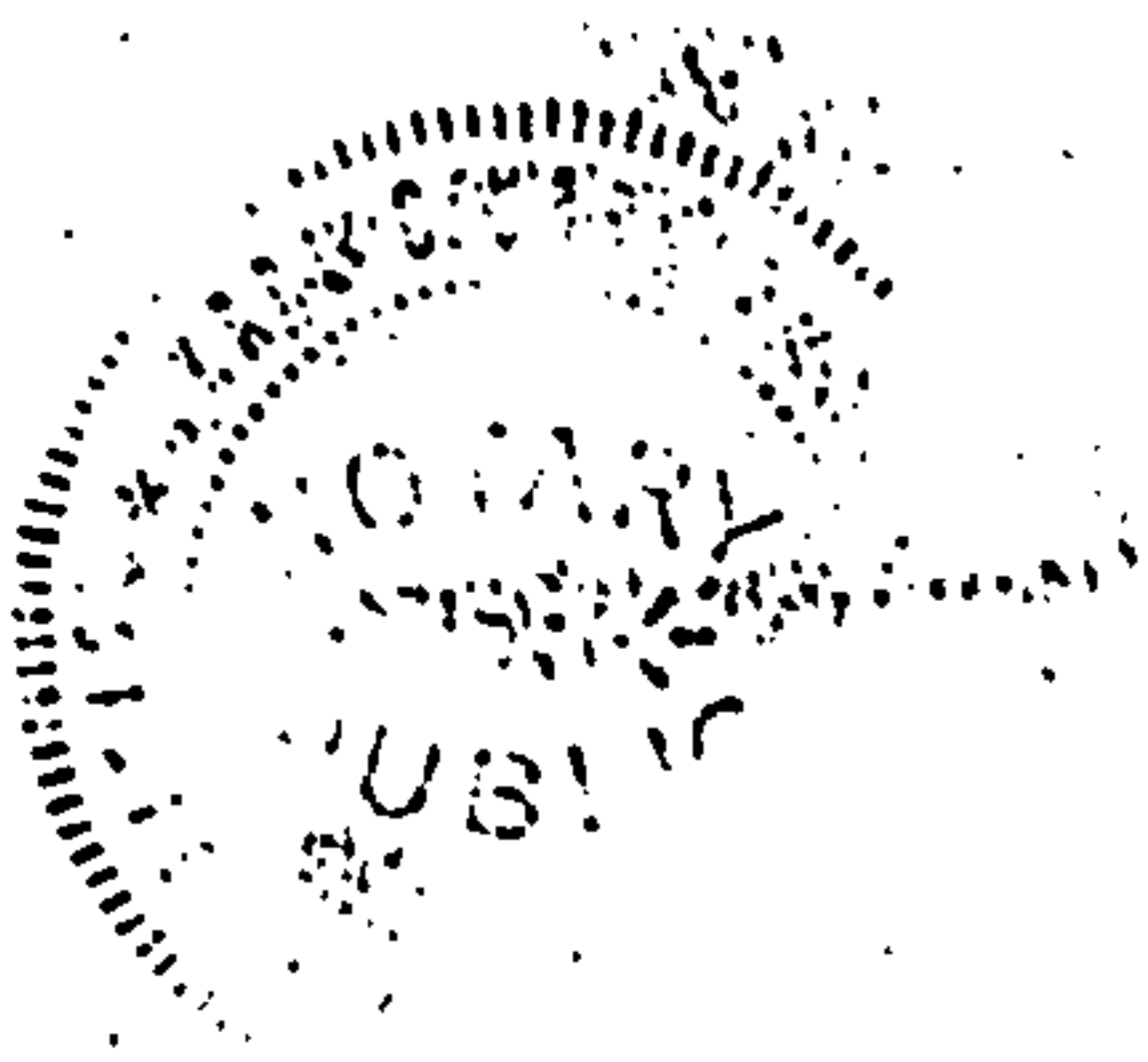
