ITEM I.

As soon after my demise as may be convenient, I desire that all of my debts as may be legally due, be paid, including therewith any administration expense and inheritance or estate taxes as are correctly levied against my estate; and I clothe my Executrix, hereinafter named, with such powers as may be necessary to realize funds in order to accomplish same.

ITEM II.

I, hereby, constitute and appoint Anita Welsh Harrison, my wife, as Executrix of this my last will and testament, and I direct that my said Executrix shall not be required to give bond or to file an inventory or appraisal of my estate in any court in any state.

ITEM III.

All the rest, residue and remainder of my property, real, personal, or mixed, wheresoever situated, I give, devise and bequeath to my wife, Anita Welsh Harrison, absolutely. As a matter of information, my personal property consists of my personal effects, including, but not limited to, one or more automobiles, cash, checking and savings accounts, notes receivable, stocks, bonds, and other evidences of ownership of personal property. My real estate, at this date, consists of my home at 2845 Vestavia Forest Drive, Jefferson County, Alabama; 1/2 undivided interest in an apartment house and the land on which same is situated at Columbiana, Alabama, known as "The Robinson-Lyons Property", and 1/2 undivided interest in a track of land consisting of 40 acres
