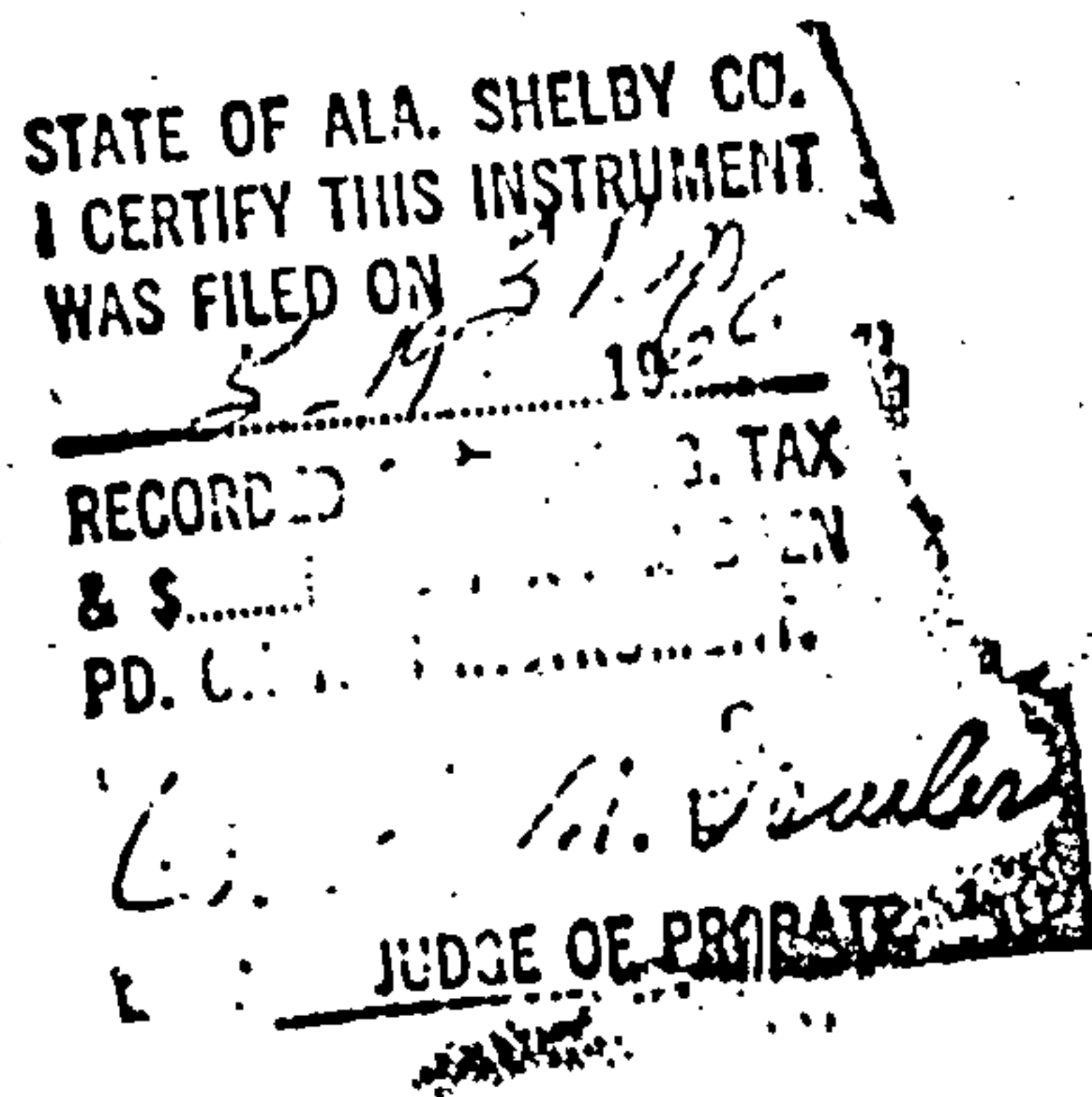
Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared Floyd Atkinson, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is Floyd Atkinson. I am a Registered Land Surveyor, having Registry No. 1352. I have done quite a bit of surveying in Montevallo, Alabama and I recently surveyed a tract of land which Mrs. Minnie F. Houlditch owns which includes Lots 6, 7 and 12 of Houlditch Subdivision and certain land lying north and northwest thereof as described in my survey, all being a part of or adjoining Houlditch Subdivision. There has been pointed out to me a copy of Houlditch Subdivision which is recorded in Map Book 4 page 39 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. Said survey shows the lines of additional property adjoining said survey. One of the lines of additional property is shown on the map as running 600 feet in a southeasterly direction and then continues to run in an easterly direction to King's Street. The property conveyed to Minnie F. Houlditch on February 27, 1933, as shown by deed recorded in Deed Book 95 page 239 in said Probate Office, shows a line of adjoining property as running, "thence south 73 deg. east along the line of said Robert Merryweather tract 600 feet; thence north 78 deg. east 80 feet; thence east 837.3 feet to the west line of King's Highway". Said Houlditch Subdivision map fails to show the line described as, "thence north 78 deg. east 80 feet". Upon making a survey of a portion of the land, I have surveyed said lines and find the line described as "thence north 78 deg. east 80 feet" is on the ground and should have been shown on the Houlditch Subdivision.
