WARRANTY DEED, JOINTLY FOR LIFE WITH REMAINDER TO SURVIVOR,

STATE OF ALABAMA
SHELBY COUNTY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of One Hundred Dollars and other good and valuable consideration to the undersigned grantors in hand paid by the GRANTEES herein, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, we, Blanche McGraw, a widow; Sigma McGraw, a widow; Mary A. McGraw, an unmarried person; R. T. McGraw and Peggy M. Taylor and husband, Barnes Taylor and wife, Lallouise F. McGraw; and Lucy Darden and husband, G. C. Darden (herein referred to as grantors) do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Grady R. Davis and Bonnie F. Davis (herein referred to as GRANTEES) for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion, the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Commence at an iron stob located in the southerly corner of the intersection of College street and Blue springs road, the same being the northwest corner of a lot heretofore conveyed to James Jackson Fleming and Faye Fleming; run thence east 100 feet along the south side of Blue springs road to an iron stob, the same being the northeast corner of said James Jackson and Faye Fleming lot and said iron stob being the point of beginning of the lot herein conveyed; thence run east along the south boundary line of said Blue springs road 120 feet to a monument; thence south 100 feet to a monument; thence west 120 feet to a monument which is the southeast corner of James Jackson and Faye Fleming lot; thence north along the east boundary line of said Fleming lot 100 feet to point of beginning; being situated in the NE_{1/4} of NE_{1/4} of section 15, Township 19, Range 2 East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said GRANTEES for and during their joint lives and upon the death of either of them, then to the survivor of them in fee simple, and to the heirs and assigns of such survivor forever, together with every contingent remainder and right of reversion.

And we do for ourselves and for our heirs, executors and administrators covenant with the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of said premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as aforesaid; that we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said GRANTEES, their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.
