2. Section 6 of said agreement shall be and hereby is amended by adding at the end of said section the following:

"It is understood and agreed that, notwithstanding the covenants, terms, conditions, and provisions of this Section 6, the Grantors do not assume any personal liability for any injurios or damages referred to in this Section 6, and

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nothing contained in this Section 6 shall be considered or construed to impose upon Grantors, or either of them, or upon their heirs, personal representatives, successors, or assigns, any personal liability for any of such injuries or damages referred to in this Section 6."

Said agreement dated February 1, 1965, as herein amended shall ramain in full force and effect in accordance with and subject to all of the covenants, terms, conditions and provisions thereof.
