All that part of Lot 23, Block "A", Nickerson's Addition to Alabaster, as recorded in Map Book 3, page 69 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, that lies northeast of the right of way of Pederal Highway No. 65, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

It is, therefore, upon consideration of this Court, CONSIDERED, ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by this Court as follows:

- 1. The complainant is entitled to relief prayed for in its bill & complaint, and the fee simple title claimed by complaints in said lands has been duly proven.
- 2. The complainant is the owner of the hereinafter described land and has an absolute fee simple title thereto, free of all liens or encumbrances except the lien for non-delinquent ad valorem taxes, and complainants' said title to the hereinafter described land is hereby established and all doubts and disputes concerning the same are hereby cleared up, to-wit:

All that part of Lot 23, Block"A", Nickerson's Addition to Alabaster, as recorded in Nap Book 3, Page 69 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, that lies northeast of right of way of Federal Highway No. 65, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

3. None of the respondents in this came has any right, title, interest, lien or encumbrances on said lands or any part thereof

- 6. The Guardian ad Litem in this cause is awarded the amount of \$25.00 as payment for his services as such Guardian ad Litem, the same to be taxed as a part of the cost herein.
- 7. The complainant shall pay the cost of this proceeding, for which let execution issue.
