My name is Ernest Carden. I am over the age of 21 and reside in Shelby County, Alabama in the vicinity of the land described hereinbelow. I knew W. O. Murphy and his wife Ethel Murphy during their lifetime and I know that the said W. O. Murphy and Ethel Murphy owned the following described land and other lands during their lifetime. This land is best described as:

A part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (NE¹ of SE¹) Section 2, Township 24 North, Range 15 E, Shelby County, Alabama and being more particularly described as:

Lot #3 of Murphy's Fishing Camp Subdivision as shown in Map Book 3, Page 72, in the Probate records of Shelby County, Alabama.

I know that all during 1950, W. O. Murphy and Ethel Murphy occupied and maintained a permanent home place in Overton, Alabama, and at no time during said year or at any other time did the said Murphy's claim the hereinabove described land or any part thereof to be their homestead.

I know that the said W. O. Murphy is deceased and has been for some five or six years.

My name is correctly spelled Ernest Carden, but has on occasions been inadvertently spelled Earnest Carden.
