My name is B. B. Cooney . I am 58 years of age and reside in Shelby County, Alabama. I have been familiar with the possession, claim of owner-ship and use of the following described land for more than 30 years.

The NE; of NE; and the NI; of NE; except 5.9 acres in the Northwest corner described as follows: Beginning at the Northwest corner of the NI; of NE; Section 34, Township 21 South, Mange 1 East and run South 15 rods to wet weather branch; thence up said branch in an Easterly and Northeasterly direction to the North line of said Section 34; thence West along the Section line to point of beginning of said exception.
