That your affiant has been familiar with this property for over fifty That your affiant lived on part of this land for a great number of years and farmed part of the property and has each year been over the land on many, many occasions, regularly hunting on this property for the past nine years under a hunting license granted by Milton Greene and prior to nine years under a hunting license granted by Henry W. Perry, Jr., and John P. Newsome, who acquired the land about twenty-five years ago. Mr. Perry and Mr. Newsome fenced most of the lands and ran cattle on them, and I well recall that one winter most of the cattle starved to death and you could hardly hunt because of the odor. I have actual knowledge of the fact that in the past twenty-five years only said Mr. Perry and said Mr. Newsome and said Mr. Milton Greene have been in possession of any part of said property and know that said persons were in actual possession

of said property, a good part of which was fenced and a good part of which was cultivated until about nine years ago at which time it was acquired by Mr. Milton Greene. That your affiant knows that when Mr. Milton Greene acquired said property about nine years ago, he began planting pine trees and selective cutting of the timber, cut fire lanes, granted hunting licenses and regularly inspected and checked said property. I have never heard of the title to said lands in over twenty-five years being questioned and have been over said property within the past forty-eight hours and know the boundary lines of the property and am thoroughly familiar with past ownerships of this land for over forty years. I know that when Mr. Perry and Mr. Newsome acquired the property in 1941 they put a caretaker by the name of Charlie Worthersom on the land who stayed until Mr. Stephenson became caretaker. That Mr. Stephenson was followed by a caretaker named Blankenship and that the caretakers regularly tended the property and kept up the fences and prevented poaching on the land.
