My name is Mary Etta Rhine. I am 60 years of age and have been familiar with the ownership and possession of the following designated property for more than the past forty years, having resided in the close vicinity of said property during said period of time:

A part of the NW4 of NE4 Section 9, Township 22 South, Range 2 West, described as follows: Commencing at the SE corner of said quarter-quarter section and run South 86 deg. 30 min. West 420 feet; thence run North 2 deg. 30 min. West 370 feet to point of beginning of lot herein described; thence run South 86 deg. 30 min. West 385.5 feet to East boundary of U. S. When I first remember said property, it was owned by Tom Wallace, about forty years ago, A house had been previously built on said property, but it was torn down.

Said property was conveyed by Tom Wallace and wife, Martha Wallace, to Howard McDaniel, who was also known as Howard McDonald, said Howard McDaniel and said Howard McDonald being one and the same person. The date of this conveyance was about 1946, according to my best knowledge and information. Said Howard McDaniel never lived on said property, he having lived and resided on other property in the community. If said Howard McDaniel or Howard McDonald was ever married, I did not know about it, although I did know said Howard McDaniel for a period of about five years. He has left the community, and I don't know where he is and I haven't heard from him in the past seven or eight years. I never knew any person named Daisy McDaniel or Daisy McDonald.

The above described property was conveyed by said Howard McDeniel to Willie Drake, Jr. and wife, Pearlie Mac Drake about 1949, and they subsequently conveyed said property to Oscar Deramus in 1951. Said Oscar Deramus,



about twelve years ago and shortly after he had bought said property, builta three strand barbed wire fence all around said property, and he had used
said property as a cow pasture or lot for the past twelve years and until
the present date.

To my own personal knowledge said Oscar Deramus and his predecessors in title as designated above have been in the open, continuous, notorious, undisturbed, peaceable, exclusive, hostile, actual adverse possession of said property for the past forty years and until the present date. I have never heard anyone question the title or possession of said Oscar Deramus and his predecessors in title as designated above.
