ORDER PROBATING LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

This matter coming on to be heard upon the petition of The First National Bank of Birmingham which was heretofore filed in this court for the probate of an instrument of writing purporting to be the last will and testament of William G. Nichols, deceased;

Comes now the said petitioner and moves the court to grant said petition; and also comes Tom H. Schrock who was heretofore duly appointed by the order of this court and who now consents to act as guardian ad litem for John C. Nichols, who is alleged to be of unsound mind; and it appearing to the court that the acceptances of service and/or waivers of notice by Mary Louise Nichols Curtis, Henry Nichols, and William G. Nichols have been filed in this court, and the court having ascertained by sufficient evidence that the signatures affixed thereto are the genuine signatures of said next of kin; and it further appearing to the satisfaction of the court that notice of the filing of said petition and of the time appointed for hearing the same has been given in pursuance of law and in strict accordance with the former order of this court made and entered in this cause; now, on motion of said petitioner, the court proceeds to hear said petition; and, after due proof and hearing had according to the laws of this state, the court is satisfied and is of the opinion that said instrument is the genuine last will and testament of said deceased, and that such instrument should be probated as the last will and testament of said deceased. It is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the court that said instrument be duly admitted to probate as the last will and testament of William G. Nichols, deceased, and ordered to be recorded together with the proof thereof and all other papers on file relating to this proceeding. It is further ordered that petitioner pay the costs of this proceeding.
