Now know ye, that the **UNITED STATES OF AMERICA**, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said *Robert Johnston*, the said tract above described: To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereto belonging, unto the said *Robert Johnston*, his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, *John C. Smith*, Secretary of the President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
