and to their heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereto belonging, unto the said Robert H. Nickle and Thomas Nickle

as tenants in common and not as joint tenants, and to their heirs and assigns forever,
