Boforo mo, L. E. Parker, a Motary Public in and for the State of Alabama at Large, personally appeared Reba R. Goodman, who is known to me and after first being duly sworn, deposes and says as fellows:

My name is Rebs R. Goodman . I am 63 years of age and reside in Sholby County, Alabama in the vicinity of the land described hereinboles. I have been familiar with this land and have known its possessors during the past 30 years. This land is best described as:

Southcost Quarter (SEA), Section 19, Township 20 South, Range 2 East; East Half of Northeast Quarter (Ets of NEts), Section 30, Township 20 South, Rango 2 East: Sholby County, Alabama.

I know that in about 1936, the above described land was in the possession of Roborta W. Taylor who claimed title thereto. In about 1958, the said Roberta W. Taylor conveyed this land by deed and relinquished her possession to Roberta T. Theyer and Louise Cleghorn who have continued in this position up until the present timo.

I know that Roberta T. Thayer, Louisa Cleghorn and their predecessors in title have been in the actual, continuous and exclusive pessession of the hereinabove described land for more than 30 years. Their possession has been visible, open, hostile and notorious. They have assessed this land for taxes and have paid the taxes due thereen.

I know that Roberta T. Thayer, Louisa Cleghorn and their predecessors in title have used the hereinabove described land in connection with adjacent lands for timber farming. Several years ago portions of this land was used for growing major crops of cotton and corn. They have granted easements, hunting permits and have exercised every other act necessary to the peaceful use and enjoyment of this land as was consistent with the nature of the land.

I know of no person or persons claiming any right to the hereinabove described land or disputing the possession of this land by Roberta T. Thayor, Louisa Cleghorn and their predecessors in title during the past 30 years.

I more particularly know that A. M. Word, Ernest W. Snow or their heirs have not been in the possession of the hereinabove land during the past 30 years nor have they exercised any right, act or authority over this land during this time.

I know that the hereinabove described land was not the hemostead of Kate H. Wallace or any heirs of W. W. Wallace or their spouses in October 1915, or at any ethon timi prior or since said date back as far as I can remember.

Ti know That Eduisa Aleghorn is one and the same person as Louisa T. Aleghorn.
